Consider the guide to artist talks by Sergio Gomez, Chicago-based artist and curator: Your story > your art process > influences or concerns > key works in the show > final thoughts. The questions below are in line with this guide. We will discuss this in a relaxed way and you should not feel the need to prepare answers ahead of the talk.

- 1. How did you first become interested in making art?
- 2. What materials and techniques are essential to your process?
- 3. Where do you find inspiration? What concerns do you explore in your art?
- 4. Can you talk about the works you made for this show and which are most important to you?
- 5. How has your creative practice changed over time?
- 6. What is your dream project?
